A multi-agency collaborative program located on the Enterprise Secondary School Campus. Available services include individual and family counseling, parent education, anger management and case management.

A collaborative, interagency program that provides assessment and intensive intervention services to children 0-5 and their families. Service areas include; health, early childhood education (0-3), school readiness (4-5 yr olds), mental health and social services.

Services to youth referred by Madera County Probation including individual and family counseling, parent education, anger management, and case management.

A multi-agency program that provides services for foster children. Mental health counseling, public health services, behavioral case management, social services, and psychiatric services are offered.

A collaborative program providing counseling, employment development services and additional support/educational groups for CalWORKs participants with identifiable barriers of mental health, substance abuse, and domestic violence issues.

This program serves MHSA Adult and Older Adult Full Service Partnership clientele. The Mentally Ill Offender Crime Reduction (MIOCR) project participants are also served at this location. Both programs serve adults who have been or who are at risk of incarceration.

Outpatient services for women and their families affected by alcohol and/or other drugs. Services include: individual, group, case management, intervention and Perinatal services.

Youth outpatient treatment for alcohol and other drugs. Includes individual, family and group counseling. Services include prevention, outreach, and case management.

Mental Health Board

Alcohol and Drug Advisory Board

Advisory Boards comprised of members/volunteers from the community who are appointed by the Board of Supervisors and provide support, guidance, and direction to BHS.

Mental Health Services Act (MHSA)

MHSA services are county-wide and include full service partnerships for children, transitional age youth, adults, and older adults; a socialization community drop-in center (Hope House); social supports and services; outreach and engagement; and services for the Unserved and underserved populations.
