Rebecca Martinez, County Clerk-Recorder and Registrar of Voters announced today that in the February 5, 2008 Consolidated Presidential Primary Election, voters registered with any of the qualified political parties in California (Democratic, Republican, American Independent, Green, Libertarian and Peace & Freedom) will receive only the ballot of the political party with which they are affiliated.

Voters may not choose to vote the ballot of any other political party unless they re-register to vote and affiliate with that political party.

If you would like to change the political party with which you are currently affiliated, you will need to re-register. The last day to register to vote in the February 5, 2008 Consolidated Presidential Primary Election is January 22, 2008.
