NOTICE TO ALL BIDDERS

This addendum is attached to and made part of the above-entitled plans and specifications for the County of Madera with a bid opening date of December 21, 2007.

PLANS AND/OR SPECIFICATIONS

The following changes below will be a part of and subject to provisions of the project plans and/or specifications.

The bidder is responsible for recognizing changes to the Bid Proposal as called for on this addendum and shall submit a signed copy of Addendum No. 1 with the Bid Proposal.

CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, SPECIFICATIONS:

1. **Notice to Contractors**

The following sentence is **DELETED**, "Sealed proposals will be received at the office of the County of Madera, Attention Greg Farley, 2307 West Cleveland Avenue, Madera, California, 93637, until 9:00 A.M. PST, December 21, 2008, at which time they will be publicly opened, examined and declared by the County Engineer of the County of Madera, who shall report his findings to the Board of Supervisors, at its next meeting scheduled to be held within 30 days." and shall be **REPLACED** so the sentence shall now read, "Sealed proposals will be received at the office of the County of Madera, Attention Greg Farley, 2037 West Cleveland Avenue, Madera, California, 93637, until 9:00 A.M. PST, December 21, 2007, at which time they will be publicly opened, examined and declared by the County Engineer of the County of Madera, who shall report his findings to the Board of Supervisors, at its next meeting scheduled to be held within 30 days."

2. **Special Provisions, SP-2**

The following words shall be **DELETED**, "fourteen (14)" and shall be **REPLACED** by "thirty (30)" so the sentence shall now be read as, "The Contractor shall begin on-site construction within ten (10) calendar days of issuance of the Notice to Proceed and shall diligently prosecute the total work involved to completion before the expiration of thirty (30) calendar days, from the starting date specified in the Notice to Proceed."

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Madera hereby invites sealed proposals for the construction of Irrigation Rehabilitation of Parksdale Park, Madera County, California. Reference is made to the Madera County Code available at www.madera-county.com/countycode/index.htm.

Sealed proposals will be received at the office of the County of Madera, Attention Greg Farley, 2307 West Cleveland Avenue, Madera, California, 93637, until 9:00 A.M. PST, December 21, 2008, at which time they will be publicly opened, examined and declared by the County Engineer of the County of Madera, who shall report his findings to the Board of Supervisors, at its next meeting scheduled to be held within 30 days. Any questions concerning the Plans, Special Provisions and Contract Documents shall be directed to the County Engineer at (559) 675-7820.

The Instructions to Bidders and other Contract Documents are available at the County of Madera, for examination without charge, and reference is made thereto for particulars.

Copies of Plans, Special Provisions and Contract Documents may be secured at the County of Madera office, 2307 West Cleveland Avenue, Madera, California, 93637, upon payment of a fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00). None of the aforementioned fees are refundable. Any Addendums to these Plans, Special Provisions and Contract Documents will be forwarded to the bidder by fax.

The Board of Supervisors has ascertained the general prevailing rate of per diem wages, as said term is defined in California Labor Code 1773.1, including the rate for health and welfare, pension, vacation and similar benefits, in the locality of the County of Madera for each craft, classification, or type of worker needed to execute the contract, which said rates are on file in the office of the County of Madera and are set forth in the Contract Documents above referred to and are hereby specified for this construction work.

Bids are required for the entire work described in the Engineer's Estimate of Quantities following. The quantities are approximate only, being given as a basis for the comparison of bids, and the County does not expressly or by implication agree that the actual amount of work will correspond therewith but reserves the right to increase, or decrease, the amount of any class or portion of the work, or to omit portions of the work, as may be deemed necessary or advisable by the Engineer.

The Board of Supervisors reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to award or reject any combination of items as it sees fit, and to waive any informality in any bid received.

No contract will be awarded to a Contractor who has not been licensed in accordance with the provisions of the Contractor's State License Law, California Business and Professions Code, Division 3, Chapter 9, as amended, and whose bid is not on the proposal form included in the Contract Document. A valid California Contractor's license, Class A (General Engineering) or C27 (Landscape and Irrigation) is required for this project.

A cashier's check or certified check or bidder's bond, for the amount of not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount of the bid, shall accompany each proposal, drawn payable to the order of the County of Madera, as a guarantee that the bidder will, after being notified of the acceptance of his bid, make a contract with the County of Madera in accordance therewith, and will furnish the

required contractor's bonds. The bonds required of the successful bidder are a faithful performance bond in the amount of one hundred ten percent (110%) of said bid and a payment bond in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the amount of said bid, in accordance with the provisions of Sections 3247-3251 of the California Civil Code. If the successful bidder fails to execute the contract for which the bid is accepted and fails to furnish the required bonds within ten (10) days after the mailing of notice of the award of the contract to the successful bidder, the Board of Supervisors shall have just cause for annulment of the award and forfeiture of the proposal guarantee. In this case, the Board of Supervisors reserves the right to award the contract to one of the other bidders or reject all bids. Proof of insurance (Certificate of Insurance) certifying coverage in the minimum amounts required by these Special Provisions shall be submitted to the County of Madera before 5:00 p.m. on the second business day following the opening of bids or as extended in writing by the County. The County encourages the Contractor to submit the required proof of insurance at the time of the bid opening to allow the County to check it for completeness so that the Contractor can make any necessary revisions prior to such deadline.

Immediately following the actual execution of the contract and furnishing of the required contractor's bonds, the Board of Supervisors will return the bidders' guarantees accompanying the other proposals. All bids are to be made on the forms to be furnished by the Engineer as designated in the foregoing paragraphs.
