Community Services and Supports Program Update: May 21, 2008

❖ **Full Service Partnerships**

- Current Caseloads
  - 18 Child/Youth
  - 14 Transition Age Youth
  - 13 Adult
  - 14 Older Adult

❖ **General Systems Development Programs**

- New Clients Served January 2008 – March 2008 (in addition to ongoing cases)
  - 68 Expansion Clinicians
  - 67 Supportive Services and Structure
  - 39 Hope House

❖ **Outreach and Engagement**

- New Clients Served January 2008 – March 2008 (in addition to ongoing cases)
  - 60 Outreach Clinician

The duties for this position have been modified and focused on engagement services for the Full Service Partnerships do to the difficult in engage this hard to reach population. This is primarily for the Adult and Older Adult population, as the children and youth are engaged as part of a family or care provider unit, which does not require extensive engagement services.

❖ **MHSA Housing Program**

This program was added to the Community Services and Supports component of the MHSA after the law was passed. This program is to develop permanent supportive housing for people experience experiencing severe mental illness/serious emotional disturbance and when appropriate, their families. This program is currently in the stakeholder planning process. The next meeting will be held on May 25, 2008. There are also limited housing funds for temporary housing under General System Development and emergency housing under the Full Service Partnerships and Outreach and Engagement.
