ORDINANCE NO. 525-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MADERA COUNTY CODE SECTION  
18.98.040, SUBSECTION C, RELATING TO STRUCTURE  
REGULATIONS-VISION SETBACK LINES

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Madera, State of California, ordains  
as follows:

**SECTION 1**

Section 18.98.040, Subsection C of the Madera County Code is amended to read  
in its entirety as follows:

“C. Across each sector between any other intersecting streets or  
alleys or driveways, a vision setback line shall be established by a straight  
line connecting two points on the intersecting base setback lines, which  
points are located thirty feet distant from the intersection of the base  
setback lines. (Refer to Section 18.102.120(I) for vision setback  
requirements for driveways in commercial, institutional, and industrial  
districts.)”

**SECTION 2**

This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days' after its adoption.

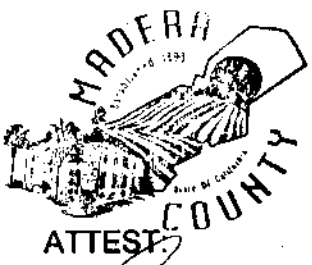
