

MADERA SHERIFF - CCW RENEWAL



1. COMPLETE A BASIC FIREARMS SAFETY COURSE

Select a presenter from the list of approved CCW Instructors/Business and make the necessary arrangements to complete the Basic Firearms Safety Course (12050 P.C.) Applicants should ask the presenter about any required equipment and class details when scheduling themselves for a class. It is your responsibility when renewing your CCW Permit, to provide the Department with a certificate issued by an approved presenter, showing that you have successfully completed the course.

2. RETURN CERTIFICATE OF COURSE COMPLETION FOR ISSUANCE OF UPDATED CCW PERMIT

Madera Office: Monday through Friday, **8:00 - 5:00 pm**, no appointment required.

Fees: **\$72.00** – cash (exact change) or check made payable to Madera County Sheriff's Department

You must bring in a copy of a current P.G. & E. bill, water bill, or gas bill, with your name and address. PO Box addresses are not acceptable.

Per our Department's General Orders, if your CCW Permit is 6 months late, you will have to start over and reapply for a CCW Permit at the cost of \$151. If you are going to be a few days late in renewing, you must notify Stephanie Johnson at the Madera Office and let us know why and approximately when you will be in to renew.

3. REVIEW PROCESS

If no questionable issues have developed since your license was issued or last renewed, it can be approved and issued the day you return the required Course Certificate. Should a questionable issued be discovered, your file would be referred to the Administrative Lieutenant for review. In such an event, you may be required to submit in writing, additional information or documents deemed necessary to satisfy all concerns to the satisfaction of the department. If after a full review of the information your renewal request is approved, you will be notified by telephone to pick up your renewed CCW Permit. If your request is denied, you will be notified by mail of both the reasons for denial and any appeal process, if appropriate.
